itinerary & details

- Arrive at Nipika no later than 9:45am and meet in the lower parking lot (by the barn)
- Average trip length is 4-5 hours from departure to arrival back at Nipika
- We transport guides and guests to the put-in in a passenger van (approx. 25 min drive)

what to wear

- Quick dry pants are the best option for the bottom (please no cotton)
- Warm thermal layer for the top
- Waterproof jacket with hood
- Footwear that can get wet and will stay fastened to your foot in currents (no flip flops allowed, and sandals must have a heel strap)
- Sun hat
- Warm hat (toque), unless weather is guaranteed to be clear skies and 25 Celsius
- Sunglasses
